

All staff members go through a rigorous selection and training process. We work throughout the year to ensure best practices in all aspects of our program.


Many of our staff are certified Wilderness First Responders and have extensive medical training. We take pride in having one of the most mature staff cohorts in the Jewish camping world!

LOCATION & FACILITIES

Nestled in the heart of Pike National Forest, Ramah is located 90 minutes from Denver.

While at Ramah, campers live in raised platform canvas tents that house 9 to 14 children and 2 to 3 staff members. Each of our tent areas has a bathroom and shower facility with hot, running water.

During their excursions, campers sleep either in tents or under tarps in sleeping bags.
