



### Seeking: Wilderness Skills Director

**Position Responsibilities:** We are seeking an experienced backcountry trip leader to lead our wilderness survival and backcountry skills program. The wilderness skills director will supervise 3-4 other staff members in teaching hour long programs in our base camp, including navigation, orienteering, shelter building, and camping skills. They will also assist in training staff for our backcountry trips program, and may lead 2-3 backpacking trips with middle & high school campers.

#### Position Qualifications:

- Significant experience in the outdoors including multi-day backpacking trips.
- WFR Certification or ability to attend our WFR course beginning May 30th.
- Experience building curriculum & teaching backcountry skills.
- Excellent team player able to work & communicate with a variety of people
- Willingness to live on our remote 360-acre ranch for 10 weeks

**About Ramah in the Rockies:** Ramah in the Rockies is a co-ed residential outdoor adventure summer camp program located in the Rocky Mountains of Colorado. Our campers range in age from 3<sup>rd</sup>-12th grade and participate in a 2-week, or 4-week program.
